1. Applications are invited in the PRESCRIBED printed FORM from eligible candidates who are Indian citizens and who are domiciled in the State of Meghalaya to fill up the under mentioned categories of vacancies in Armed Branch for the Special Forces-10 (SF-10). Application forms will be available with effect from 1st March 2014 onwards, through offices of all District Superintendents of Police and Commandants of MLP Battalions and Principal, PTS Mawroh Shillong on payment of Rs. 50/- (Rupees Fifty Only).

2. Recruitments shall be carried out to fill up the following posts carrying scales of pay as indicated against each:

6. Drivers 40
Scale of Pay: For matriculates Rs 8300-210-9770- EB -270-12200-370-16270/- (plus other allowances and special allowances as admissible under the Rules from time to time.)

For Class Nine passed Rs 7700-190-9030-EB-250-11280-340-15020/- (plus other allowances and special allowances as admissible under the Rules from time to time)

7. Followers (Only Males) 60

Scale of Pay Rs 6500-160-7620-EB-210-9510-290-12700/- (plus other allowances and special allowances as admissible under the Rules from time to time.)

The above 60 (sixty) vacancies of followers are distributed trade wise as follows:

3. 1% (One percent) of the vacancies in the serial no 1 to 6 shall be filled up from candidates who have 'specialized skills' provided that they fulfill the basic qualifications and eligibility criteria as laid down for respective category of post, and subject to the condition that the total number of persons appointed under this category shall not exceed one percent (1%) of the recruitments made in a recruitment year. For the purpose of determining eligibility under this category, duly constituted Screening Committee comprising members of the Meghalaya Police and a

representative of the Home (Police) Department will evaluate the suitability of the candidates and recommend names to the Government for its approval. The Committee will frame guidelines and norms for the selection process.

4. CANDIDATES CAN APPLY ONLY FOR ONE CATEGORY OF POSTS.
5. THE LAST DATE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATION IS 1st April 2014. APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER THE LAST DATE WILL NOT BE ENTERTAINED. ONLY ONE APPLICATION PER CANDIDATE WILL BE ALLOWED. INCOMPLETE AND/OR DEFECTIVE APPLICATIONS WILL BE REJECTED SUMMARILY.
6. The training, duties and responsibilities of the commandos/constables of the SF 10 are high risk and strenuous which would need specialized training and equipment in the chosen field of operation like jungle warfare, urban warfare, controlling riots and disaster management and mitigation. Candidates who cannot cope up with the conditions above need not apply.
7. On the spot temporary admit cards having names of candidates, post applied for and dates and venue of recruitment will be given to the candidates at the time of submission of the application forms. These temporary admit cards will be used for the PMT/PET. Final ADMIT CARDS with NAMES OF CANDIDATES, POST APPLIED FOR, DATES AND VENUE OF written test WILL BE DISTRIBUTED/ISSUED TO THE CANDIDATES IMMEDIATELY AFTER SCRUTINISING AND SCANNING OF APPLICATION FORMS AND GENERATION OF FINAL ADMIT CARDS
8. The application form should be submitted along with attested copies of the following:
 - i. 4 (four) recent passport size photographs.
 - ii. S.T./ S.C. Certificate – for S.T./ S.C. candidates as applicable.
 - iii. Age certificate as per HSLC/SSLC Certificates/Admit Cards or their equivalent certificate testifying the date of birth/age.
 - iv. Educational Qualification certificates.
 - vi. Additional qualification, if any.

Please note (Domicile/Residence certificates will be required in doubtful cases at the time of issue of admit cards/or appointment).

9. Eligibility: The following shall be the eligibility criteria for recruitment to various posts:
 1. Only Indian Citizens domiciled in Meghalaya are eligible to apply.
 2. Candidates should be able to speak read and write at least one of the regional languages of the State.

3. Other qualifications are as follows:

There will be a relaxation of 5 years in the upper age limit for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes/ Scheduled Castes.

10. The scheme of recruitment tests

Category 1 posts : For recruitment to the posts of Commandos/Constables, Mechanics, Drivers & Signal/Communication staff:-

1. Physical Efficiency Tests	-	200 marks
2. Written Examination	-	200 marks
3. Interview	-	<u>50 marks</u>
Total	-	450 marks

Note: The written examination for the post of Driver Constables shall also contain multiple choice questions on motor vehicle mechanism, spare parts, maintenance, traffic signage, etc.

Category 2 posts : For recruitment to the Posts of followers:-

1. Physical Efficiency Tests	-	200 marks
2. Trade Test cum Interview	-	<u>50 marks</u>
3. Total	-	250 marks

11. Physical Measurement Tests (PMT) : Candidates should bring the temporary admit cards to appear for the PMT. Candidates who do not meet the standards of minimum Height requirement as prescribed will be rejected and further test events of such rejected candidates will not be conducted.

12. Registration and Authentication of Candidates: After the Physical Measurement Test, the candidates with temporary admit cards will be required to register themselves at the PET registration counters at the venue of recruitment for biometric data such as Candidates' Finger Prints in respect of each candidate which will be captured by the bio-metric application software. The candidates' biometric profile will be verified before the Physical Efficiency Test. Only candidates successfully verified will be allowed for Physical Efficiency Test (Race).
13. 10 km race for male and 5.5 km race for female candidates and Timing Equipment : Each Candidate will be issued with a lockable Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) tag, to be tied to his/her leg. The automated timing equipment based on RFID technology will be geared to record start time, finish time and net time of all runners individually. Those who do not finish the race within the minimum prescribed time will be issued a rejection letter and they are not allowed to participate in other subsequent recruitment events. 10 KM race for male candidates will have to be completed within 50 minutes and 5.5 KM race for female candidates will have to be completed within 35 minutes.
Candidates who are not physically fit should not attempt this race. Candidates are advised to consult a physician about their state of health before preparing themselves to participate in the running test. The Central Recruitment Board will not be responsible for any injury sustained by a candidate during the 10 KM or 5.5 KM race.

Conduct of Written Examination

Only those candidates who qualify in the Physical Efficiency Tests will be allowed to appear at the Written Examination which will be conducted at the time, venue and date to be notified by the Central Recruitment Board. The dates and venues shall be published in Newspapers and on the departmental website.

The written examination for category 1 posts - shall consist of one paper only, comprising of elementary and basic knowledge of English, Basic Arithmetic and Basic General Awareness. This paper will be on multiple choice / OMR based basis and will carry a maximum of 200 marks. There shall be no written test for followers. For followers, a trade test of 50 marks will be conducted.

14. Medical Test : Medical Tests will be conducted only in respect of Candidates who have been selected for appointment. No fees will be paid by any candidate for medical examination.
15. Test for Specialized jobs : The Central Recruitment Board will conduct specific trade tests of qualifying nature for those candidates who have qualified in the written tests for selection of drivers, mechanics.
16. Bonus marks : The following categories of candidates shall be awarded 5 bonus marks which will be added to their total score: (i) Home Guards Volunteers (ii) Holders of a 'B' 'C' certificate of National Cadet Corps (iii) Children of Non-gazetted police personnel of Meghalaya Police. (iv) Sports persons who have represented the State at the national level. All claims for bonus marks should be indicated in the application form and supported with copies of documents in support of such claims. Original certificates from the competent authority shall be produced by the candidates claiming bonus marks, to verify the eligibility of candidates to these claims.
17. CANVASSING DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY WILL DISQUALIFY A CANDIDATE AND ANY CANDIDATE FOUND OFFERING BRIBE TO ANYONE INVOLVED IN THE RECRUITMENT

PROCESS OR IN A POSITION OF AUTHORITY SHALL BE DISQUALIFIED AND/OR BE PROSECUTED.

The marks obtained by candidates in each event will be communicated to him/her on the spot and the daily results will also be published on the Departmental website.
